




PROJECT MAP & SCOPE

This project is an opportunity to reimagine Ogden Avenue as a multimodal transportation corridor, as a hub for community activity, and as a catalyst for economic development.















CURRENT STREET CONFIGURATION




Intersections

Challenges

- Service drives create conflict points and safety issues at intersections
- Service drives create delays due to additional signal phases required

 Simplify intersections to increase safety and reduce delays








Pedestrian Experience

Challenges

 Excessively long distances to cross Ogden with no refuge spaces

Opportunities

- Reduce the size of intersections to shorten crossing distances
- Install safety features such as refuge medians, curb extensions, and raised crosswalks
- Increase sidewalk width to provide safer and more comfortable pedestrian experience





• Explore options for providing safer park access across Ogden






Corridor Identity

- Explore the Historic Route 66 as a potential theme (as identified by community stakeholders).







Each of these boards provide images of placemaking elements.































Trees / Landscaping

- Elements can be traditional or more creative



























Community Gathering Spaces
















- Gathering spaces serve as a hub for community interaction and activities

- Seating areas can help support local businesses







Pavement Design

- Colors and materials can represent a theme








- Lighting can draw our attention and invite us to explore
- Lighting can define a space and make people feel comfortable




















Community Identifiers - Light Pole

- A community driven process will help establish visual identity



























Community Identifiers - Gateways

- Can function as a gateway to define a boundary


















ALGNING WITH COMMUNITY PLANS

Community Planning Efforts

North Lawndale Quality of Life Plan – Comprehensive community plan completed in 2018.

- Prioritizes Ogden as a key community corridor for economic development and institutions.
- Recommends roadway improvements to better support pedestrians, cyclists and public transit.

INVEST South/West – Broad initiative to reactivate key commercial corridors on Chicago's south and west sides.

- Leverages public funding and land resources to attract private investment in disinvested communities
- Resulted in two active mixed-use development projects on Ogden Avenue.

Key Takeaways

- New planned developments encourage a more pedestrianfriendly environment with outdoor plaza space and parking screened behind buildings.
- New development should support retail amenities that serve community needs.
- Vacant land on the corridor is currently a challenge, but also an opportunity for transformational redevelopment.
